## History of Isle Airport

---

In 1954, the state of MN deeded vacated land to the village of Isle to be used exclusively for an airport. Construction of the airport began in 1955. By mid1956, airport construction was completed and Isle Airport received its first public license and was open for public use.

In 1967, the Isle Flying Club Inc., a MN non-profit was formed to maintain, operate, and improve the airport. At that time, Isle was a public airport and receiving public funding. Mowing and owing was done by city personal.



In the early 1980's, Isle Airport lost its 'public use' status due to new runway length rules and tall tree interference, nearly closing the airport. Isle Flying Club obtained a 'private license' and took over operation of the strip.

As of today, Isle Airport remains a city owned but private use airport operated and maintained by Isle Flying Club. ***Pilots flying into Isle must be members of the Isle Flying Club or have permission from a current member.*** Club dues as of 2018 are \$25 per year.
